

BYLAW NO. 7-00

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE CHARGING FOR
FIRE PROTECTION SERVICE

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Pense No. 160, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. Fire Response shall mean any response by:
 - (a) The Village of Pense and The Rural Municipality of Pense No. 160 Volunteer Fire Department and/or
 - (b) The Moose Jaw Fire Department for protection of person(s) and/or property.

2. The owner/recipient for whom any fire response is provided shall be responsible for the payment of a “fee for service” for each and every fire response as follows:
 - (a) Pense Volunteer Fire Department fire response- the hourly fire response call out fee.

 - (b) Moose Jaw Fire Department fire response - schedule A and schedule B fees as set out in the agreement between the City of Moose Jaw and The Rural Municipality of Pense No. 160 dated February 4, 1997.

 - (c) the costs of chemicals and other extinguishing agents, excluding water, used to extinguish or prevent and/or limit the spread of fire.

 - (d) the fees in paragraph (a) and (b) of this section shall be reduced by the amount of \$400.00 for ratepayers of the Rural Municipality of Pense No. 160 with the exception of:
 - (i) unreported controlled burns.
